### Setting up your HDTV Network is as easy as 1-2-3!

(Please read carefully and follow the recommended instructions below so that you may receive the most out of your DSTV Experience!)

#### STEP 1: UNPACKING THE EQUIPMENT

Unpack your new HD media player, Ethernet cable, and power supply. **Do not plug in the power until you have connected the other cables.**

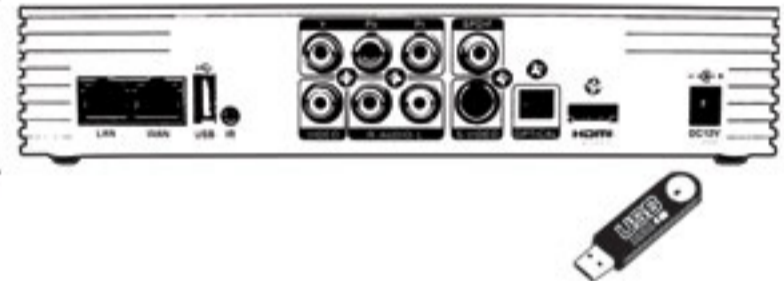


#### STEP 2: NETWORK SETUP

(a) First, take the Ethernet cable and connect it to the Ethernet port (LAN) on the back of the media player. Now insert the other end of the cable into your network jack that has Internet access.

(b) Second, connect the RCA cable to the back of the media player. Plug the other end into your HD Television. If you have multiple televisions, plug the other end into the HDMI input on your A/V rack.\* Connect the USB thumbdrive key (provided) to activate the box.

(c) This media player is HD capable. If you would like to utilize its HD capabilities, then connect an HDMI cable (not provided) to the back of the media player and plug the other end into your HD Television. If you have multiple televisions, plug the other end into the HDMI input on your A/V rack.\* Last, connect the USB thumbdrive key (provided) to activate the box.



#### STEP 3: POWER UP

Connect a surge protector to the power cord. Next, insert the small end of the power cord into the back of the media player and the other end into any available power outlet. \*Note: Please make sure that you do not have too many connections going in one outlet to avoid overloading the electrical breakers. Thank You!
